

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
TUOLUMNE CITY SANITARY DISTRICT  
AUTHORIZING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS WITH THE STATE WATER  
RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD UNDER THE STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF)  
PROGRAM FOR THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM PROJECT – PHASE II AND  
DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Tuolumne City Sanitary District (the "Entity") desires to construct and/or reconstruct certain public facilities and improvements relating to its Wastewater Collection System Phase II project, including certain collection system facilities, clarifiers, pipelines, pumps, lift stations, control systems and other infrastructure and/or facilities (the "*Wastewater Collection System Project – Phase II*"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Entity intends to pay for the construction and/or reconstruction of the *Wastewater Collection System Project – Phase II* or portions of the *Wastewater Collection System Project – Phase II* with moneys ("Project Funds") provided by the State of California, acting by and through the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors finds that the *Wastewater Collection System Project – Phase II* is necessary to improve operating efficiency, reduce overall operating costs and to comply with regulatory requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and desirable to designate an Entity representative to act on behalf of the Board of Directors in signing and submitting various applications, agreements, requests, reports, and other information required by the State Water Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors designates the General Manager as the *Authorized Representative* as indicated below.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE TUOLUMNE CITY SANITARY DISTRICT DOES HEREBY  
RESOLVE, ORDER AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:**

The General Manager (the "Authorized Representative") or designee is hereby authorized and directed to sign and file, for and on behalf of the Entity, Financial Assistance Applications for a financing agreement from the State Water Resources Control Board for the planning, design, and construction of the *Wastewater Collection System Project – Phase II* consisting of a *Planning Grant* and a *Construction Grant*.

This Authorized Representative, or his/her designee, is designated to provide the assurances, certifications, and commitments required for the financial assistance application, including executing a financial assistance agreement from the State Water Resources Control Board and any amendments or changes thereto.

The Authorized Representative, or his/her designee, is designated to represent the Entity in carrying out the Entity's responsibilities under the financing agreement, including certifying disbursement requests on behalf of the Entity and compliance with applicable state and federal laws.
